Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Greenfield Water Utility Service Line Replacement in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Greenfield located at 10 S. State St., Greenfield, IN 46140. The funding would be used for the replacement of up to 182 water service lines in the city as part of compliance efforts under the Lead and Copper Rule Improvement law.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the replacement of aging galvanized lines prevents the future risk of service disruption, water loss, and degraded customer reliability. This project advances essential service reliability by removing high-risk and aging service line materials, reducing leak and break events, and improving system resiliency in an area with limited ability to absorb unexpected repair costs.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
